



#### ☐ Notes for Document Submission

- All documents should be original copies. If documents are not written in Korean or English, they should be translated into either Korean or English and notarized.
  - \* Validity of notarization within 1 year prior to the date of submission.
- If the successful applicant is a high school graduate-to-be, a certificate of graduation must be submitted to the International Office.
- Unless you submit a TOEFL transcript, you should write your User Name and Password for the ETS website (https://toefl-registration.ets.org/TOEFLWeb/) on the top right-hand side of your cover letter.

#### [Reference 1] Certificate of Nationality(applicant & parents), Certificate of Family Relationship

Chinese national must submit household registry: When the names of applicant and their parents are on the household registry, applicants do not need to prepare a Certificate of Family Relationship.

Ethnic Koreans from Russia·Uzbekistan·Kazakhstan: Must submit a verification document.

#### [Reference 2] Transcript of completed education and certificate of (scheduled) high school graduation

All international students must submit a high school diploma and transcripts (freshmen), previous university's transcripts, and a Certificate of Enrollment (transfer) recognized by one of the following methods to the International Office by 2018. 9. 28.(Fri) (with the exception of the official seal of the principal of one of the Korean International Schools authorized by the Minister of Education)

- 1) Obtaining Apostille stamps on documents (graduation & transcript of high school) in case the student has attended or graduated from school(s) in a country that is a member to the Hague Convention; or
  - \* see Appendix #3 'Members to the Apostille Convention' at page 14
- 2) Obtaining certifications of documents (graduation & transcript of high school) from the Korean embassy or consular office in the country where the applicant's school is located; or from the government of the country. where the applicant's school is located in Korea.
- 3) The verification at the website of the China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center (www.cdgdc.edu.cn).
  - Only for whom receive(d) degree from a chinese university. It will take about 3~4 weeks

#### [Reference 3] Certificate of Financial Support

Bank deposit certificate in applicant's name verifying USD \$18,000 or more, or a certificate of remittance (The certificate should have been issued within the past 30 days) or certificate of money transfer to Korea or certificate of money exchange.

- Valid until the date indicated on the document, but we can only accept a document that has been issued within the past 6 months (Base date: Last day of Submission of Documents).

#### 5. Application Fee: KRW #60,000 or USD \$70 (Internet fee included)

- 1) If applicant fails to pay the application fee, his or her applications will not be recognized.
- 2) Once the application is completed and the application fee payment is processed, there will be no cancel, and no refund policy of the application fee.

#### 6. Selection Method

#### Admissions decisions are based on document screenings and interviews (by each department)

#### 1) Document Screening

- The Admissions Committee reviews a number of documents: records of past studies (such as GPA), Study Plan and Personal Statement, and financial documents.
  - \* Applicants who are admitted only with documents will not need to do an interview, and they will be notified by each department.

#### 2) Interview

- a) Applicants in Korea: Face-to-face interview (will be conducted at each department's designated place)
- b) Applicants Overseas: Phone or Skype interview

#### 3) NOTE on Interviews


- a) Applicants in Korea must arrive at the designated place with the test identification slip and an ID card (passport, Alien Registration Card, and other documents) on the day of the interview.
- b) In principle, applicants overseas should be interviewed by phone or video conferencing, so it is important to write your exact phone number for the phone interview.
- c) If the applicant uses a substitute during the interview, admission will be canceled even if he or she has been admitted.
- d) The Department of Global Studies: Conduct essay tests and interviews in English. The Department of Electronics Engineering: Conduct face-to-face interviews (no telephone or video-conference interviews).

### 7. Applying Online

Applicants are advised to read the 'Admissions Guide for International Students for the School Year 2018 (Fall Semester)' thoroughly before submitting an online application, and after applying online, should submit required documents.

#### Please follow the steps below when applying:

- 1) Go to PNU homepage (http://go.pusan.ac.kr) or JINHAK website (http://www.jinhakapply.com).
- 2) Sign in (you need to join if you not a member).
- 3) Fill out the application form and upload the applicant's ID photo (3 cm × 4 cm).
- 4) Double-check all the entries in the application form.
- 5) Pay application fees. Make sure the application is successfully completed and submitted.
- 6) Print out the test identification slip.
  - ※ In case Internet access is not available, documents could be submitted via registered mail or in person by the application deadline(include application fee KRW ₩60,000 or USD \$70 and 2 ID photos (3 x 4 cm)).



#### 8. Notes on Applying

- 1) Application deadline is until 2018. 4. 27.(Fri) at 6 p.m. Applications are considered completed when all entries are filled in and the application fee is paid.
- 2) Print out an test identification slip after completing the application online.
- 3) Applicants who fail to submit the required documents by the specified dates, even if their online applications are completed, will be excluded from the screening process.
- 4) The phone number (landline or mobile phone) of applicants should be filled in precisely. Inform the International Office if the number changes.(Admin. TEL: 82-51-510-3856, FAX: 82-51-510-3851 EMAIL: iadmission@pusan.ac.kr)
- 5) The last day of the application period might be busy. We recommend applying as early as possible.

#### 9. Announcement of Successful Applicants and Cash Registration

#### 1) Announcement of successful applicants and Printing of admission letter

- b) Place: PNU homepage (http://go.pusan.ac.kr)
- c) Notes
  - Successful applicants should print out a notification of admission and a registration deposit bill available at http://go.pusan.ac.kr. Be sure to meet all the requirements stated in the guidelines and other related information in order to prevent cancellation of admission.
  - Successful applicants who are admitted to an undergraduate college will be assigned to a department (major) in accordance with the selection criteria prescribed by each department at the end of their first or second year (with the exception the School of Mechanical Engineering)
  - If the applicant is announced, the applicant who fails to submit Certificate of TOPIK or Certificate of the Korean Language Program offered by PNU's International Language Institute will be selected as a preliminary candidate. The applicant must submit the certificate by 2018. 8. 13.(Mon).

(Admission will be canceled for non-submission or unsatisfied level of TOPIK)

### 10. Other Information

- 1) Submitted documents and application fees will not be returned or refunded, and the department and major selected cannot be changed.
- 2) All notifications during the application period (including the announcement of admitted applicants) shall be made on the PNU Admissions website (http://go.pusan.ac.kr).
- 3) Applicants are responsible for errors made during the application process that may result in cancellation of admission, such as failure to submit required documents, errors or omissions in the documents, failure to fulfill the requirements indicated in the guidelines, indistinct addresses listed, correspondence failures, failure to check

- the list of successful applicants, failure to execute procedures necessary to enter the country, and others.
- 4) If the applicant gained admission illegally, such as by forgery or alteration of documents or translation errors of documents, and this is discovered while at school or after graduation, admission will be canceled and all academic records will be deleted even if the applicant has graduated.
- 5) Applicants who have Korean names should submit documents confirming their Korean names; ex) transcripts, diplomas, official documents of Korea such as a Certificate of Marriage or an Application for Naturalization.
  - \* The Korean name on the notarization of translation is not admitted.
- 6) If the applicant is a high-school graduate-to-be, a certificate of graduation must be submitted to <a href="PNU International Office by 2018">PNU International Office by 2018</a>. 9. 28.(Fri) 18:00. If the applicant fails to do so without a valid reason, admission can be canceled.
- 7) International students are required to register for a medical insurance program designated by PNU against injuries or sickness, or submit a proof of insurance document registered individually. The insurance compensation limits must be a minimum of USD \$100,000. Uninsured, the applicant cannot move into an assigned dormitory room and course registration can be canceled.
- 8) Matters that are not stipulated in the guidelines shall comply with the admissions procedures and regulations of the university. For more information, visit the PNU Admissions website (http://go.pusan.ac.kr) or contact the International Office at 82-51-510-3856 or iadmission@pusan.ac.kr.
- 9) During formal school years at PNU, students who fail to obtain compulsory credit for graduation may not graduate when the regular semester period is over.
- 10) Certificates of Admission will be distributed by the International Office. Successful applicants can receive the certificate after 2018. 6. 27.(Wed) at 10:00.
   (Distribution: International Office, 2nd Floor of the Main Admin. Bldg.)
- 11) Applicants who register at two or more universities for the same semester are subject to have their admission canceled.
- 12) Successful applicants should change their visa at the Busan Immigration Office or at the Korean embassy (or consulate) in their home country to get a student visa after acquiring the Certificate of Admission from the International Office.
- 13) Successful applicants should pay special attention to the 'Guidelines for Successful Applicants' in order to be informed about visas, dormitories, insurance, airport pick-up, course registration or tuition fee payment within the designated period located on the PNU Admissions homepage (http://go.pusan.ac.kr), or the PNU International homepage (http://international.pusan.ac.kr) after the announcement.


